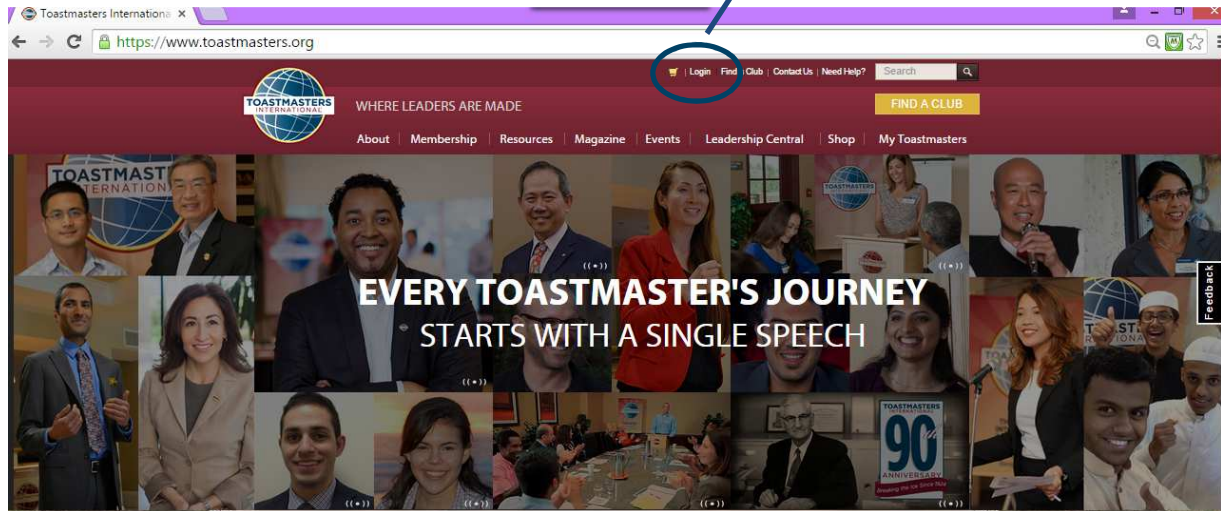


How to Assign/Delegate an International Election Club Proxy

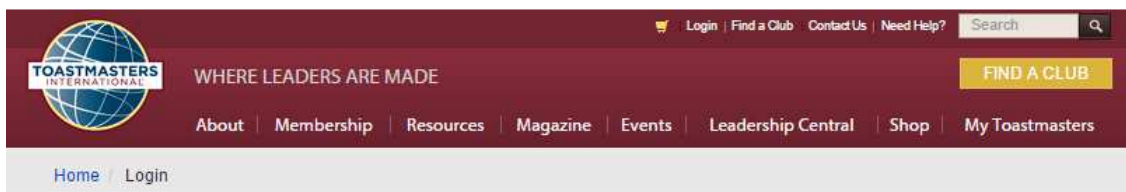
Step 1. Go to www.toastmasters.org

Step 2. Click on “Login” at the top of the home screen.



Step 3. Enter your username (your email address you have registered with Toastmasters International) and your password.

** If this is your first time logging in, enter your email address and hit “Forgot Password” – a temporary password will be emailed to you and then you can log in and create a password.
